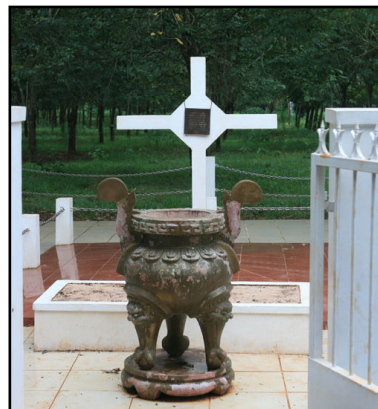

Dave Sabben will host a further tour of **SEVEN**
more of the decisive battlefields of the three Indo-China Wars. We fly to HUE where
we will visit **Hue Citadel** (Tet '68), **Dong Ha** (Tet '72), the **DMZ**, **Khe Sanh** ('68),
Hamburger Hill ('69), **Da Nang** (Red Beach II, China Beach, Marble Mt) and other
sites. Then to **Hanoi** to visit sites of military significance including the Army Museum
which has the tank that broke down the Palace gates in Saigon in 1975, the "Hanoi
Hilton" prison, the wreckage of a B52 in Hanoi and other sites. We will then see the
Dien Bien Phu battlefield and **General Giap's Bunker**. Plus, we'll discuss **TWO**
other decisive battlefields: **Lam Son** (in Laos, '71) and **Dich Van**.
The extension tour will end with a 2-night R&R at **HA LONG BAY**.
