VVCS is located in **Brisbane, Southport, Maroochydore** and **Townsville** and has an extensive network of contracted counsellors available throughout Queensland.

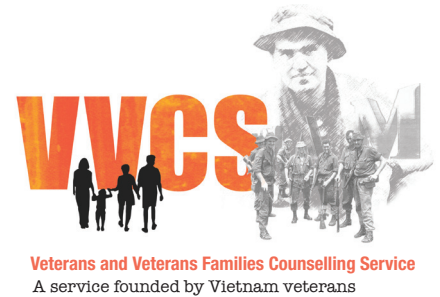
